Each school year, districts/schools must develop a policy or review the existing policy for providing Academic Intervention Services (AIS). Due to the delayed <u>availability of the 2023 Grades 3-8 English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics test results</u> the New York State Board of Regents approved a change to Commissioner's Regulation 100.2 (ee) regarding the process for identifying students to receive AIS. Effective July 18, 2023, districts/schools may, but are not required to, conduct the two-step identification process (outlined below) for grade 3-8 students during the 2023-2024 school year. Those districts/schools that do not use the two-step identification process may make an identification based solely on district/school-developed procedures applicable to all grade 3-8 students during the 2023-2024 school year.
